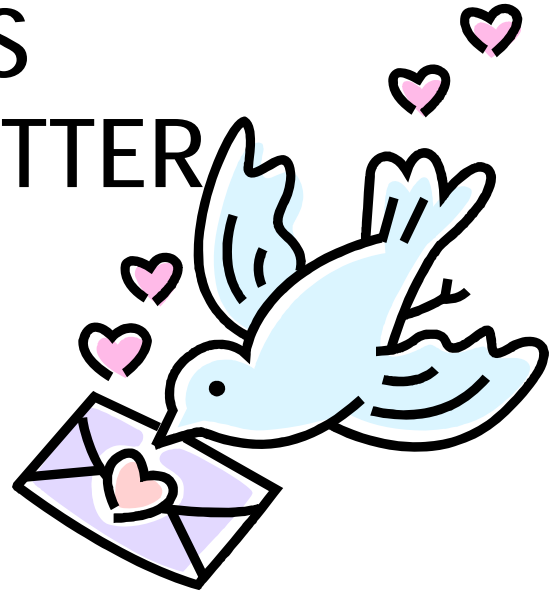


Holiday Music Lessons
