PTA NEWS

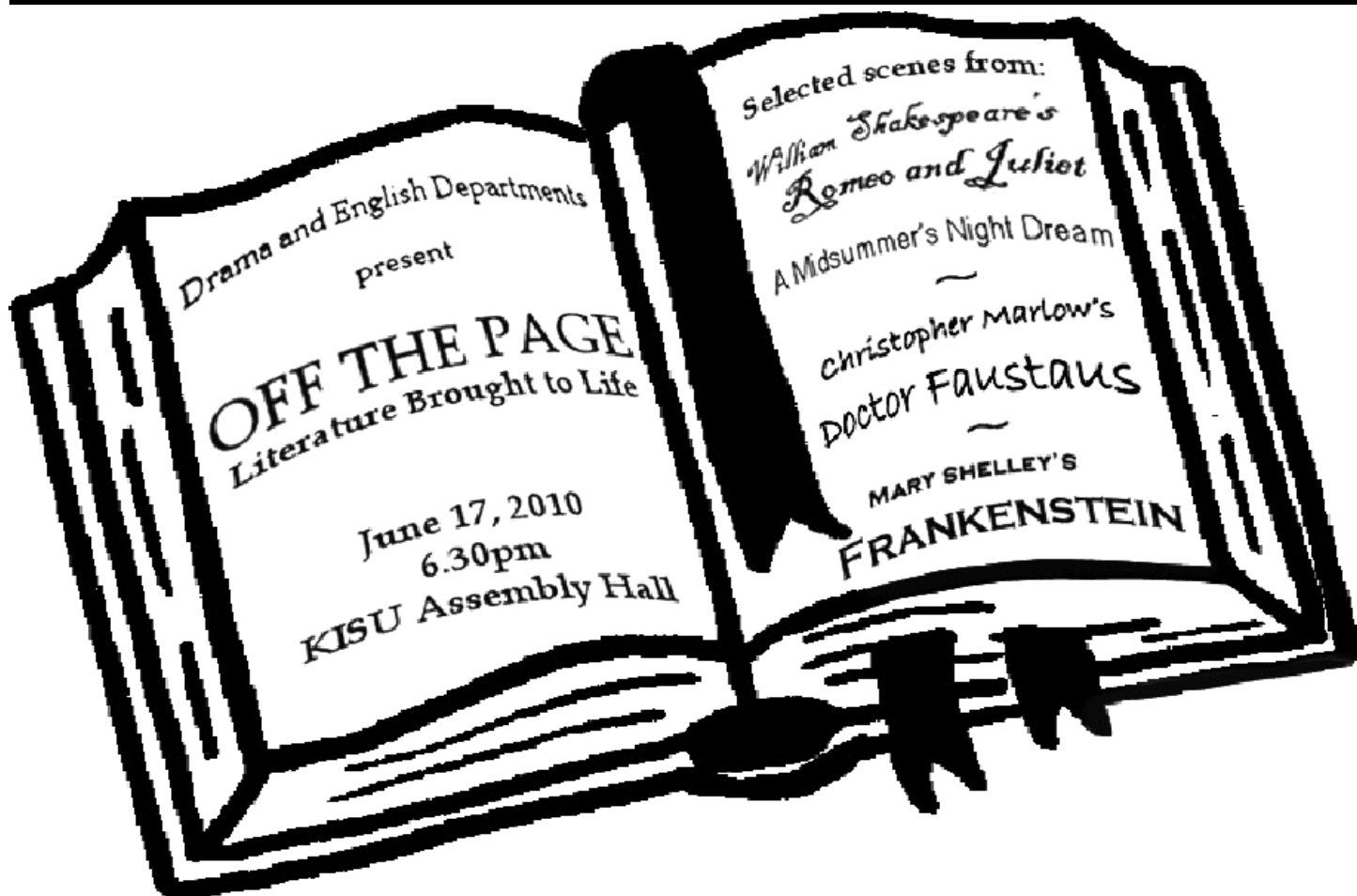
AGM
